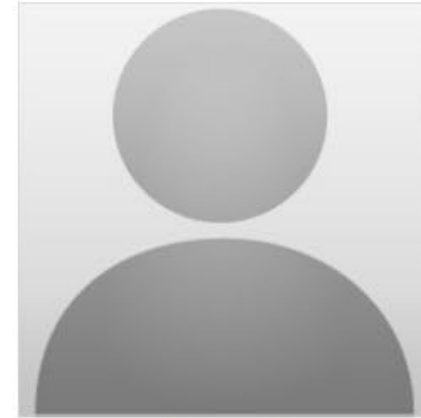

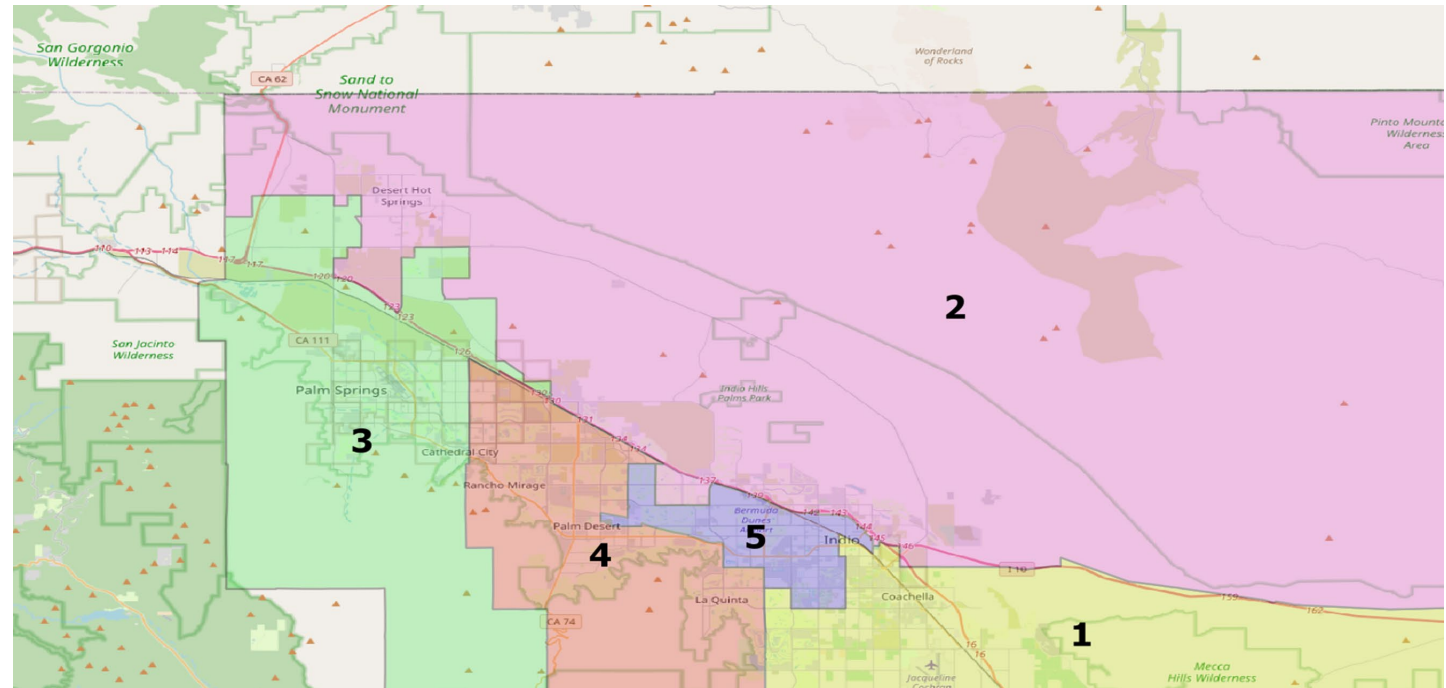

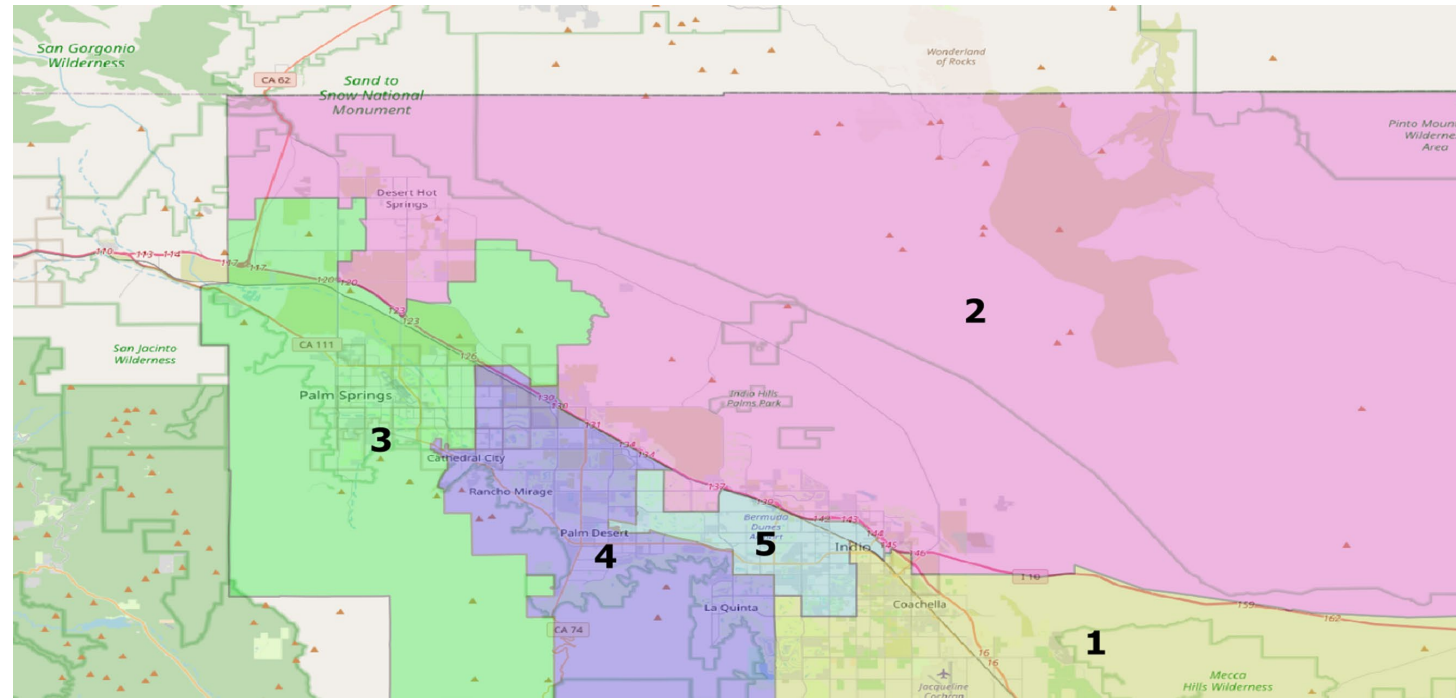
Summary Of Changes Option 1

- No changes to Districts 1, 4 & 5.
- Excess was moved from District 2 into 3 to create a lower total deviation.
- Districts 2 & 3 are on the same election cycle so moving between the two does not affect when a person gets to vote.
- Jagged boundary lines in District 3 are a result of irregular municipal boundaries, as it is important to keep municipalities together if possible.
- Total deviation is 6.48%, compared to the current deviation of 10.97%.



Summary Of Changes Option 2

- No changes to Districts 1 & 5.
- 95% of the changes involve moving populations from Districts 2 and 3 into Cathedral City in District 4.
- A total of 6,942 persons (3,858 voters)(6% of voters) were moved from District 2 into a combination of District 3 and District 4.
- District 4 is on a separate voting cycle from 2 & 3, so all attempts were made to move as few voters as possible.
- Total deviation is 1.77%

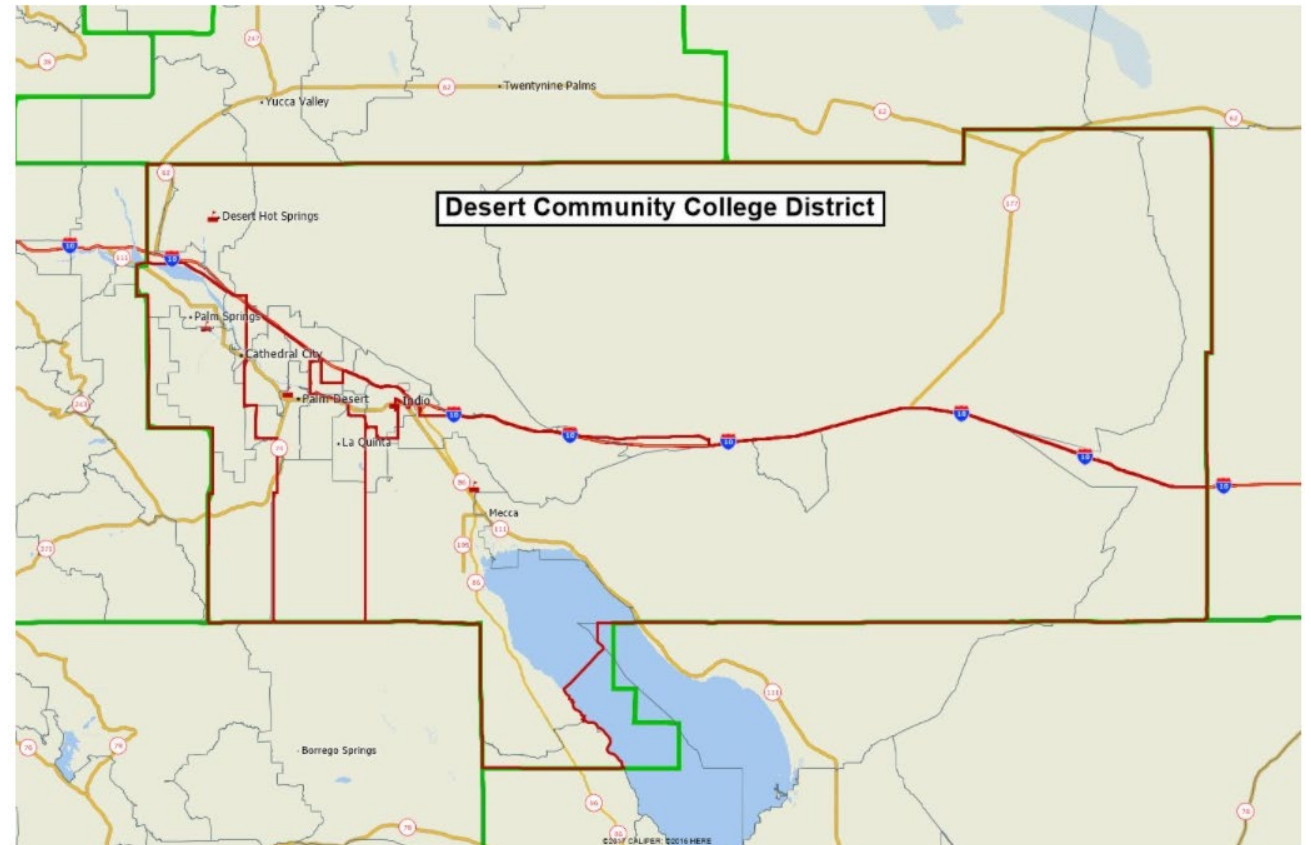
